

ZEN BEI BUTOKU KAI SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS
THE O'SENSEI RICHARD KIM EDUCATIONAL FUND

This fund is available for any student of the martial arts who has studied a martial art for over two years and is currently practicing a martial art.

Scholarships funds are available to any martial arts student regardless of race, age, gender or sexual orientation.

Funds are to be use for either College or Universtiy tuition or expenses or for tuition and or expenses for a mration arts class or seminar. The funds need not be apply exclusively to the martial arts physical training but can be the study of philosophy and or history of a martial art or arts or a related field. Funds awarded are a gift.

Funds must be requested for specific school tuition or seminars fees A Brief description of the class's the tuition is paying for should also be included with the request for funds. Request for funds to be accompanied by a typed paper describing what his/her martial arts training has meant to the applicant. Please include in this paper a personal description of what the training has to do with the applicant's personal growth. This paper is too be between three thousand and ten thousand words. Please also include the applicants martial arts training history with dates of training, instructor or instructors, style of martial art, a brief histroy of the martial art or arts that the applicant trained in and any letter of recommendation from his or her martial arts instructors. Maximum awards available are currently up too 5000.00 dollars per year. The awards will be awarded strictly on the merit of the paper and availability of funds requested. The committee shall meet a minimum of once every three months to review and analyze scholarship requests and vote on awarding scholarships and monetary amounts of scholarships by a simply majority vote. All monies are to be used for educational purposes only and must be itemized by applicant. Funds will be dispersed directly to a school or institute or for reimbursement of school tuition with valid proof of payment by scholarship recipient.

Applicant's scholarship request to be submitted to the ZBBK Scholarship Committee in writing via regular mail no later then four months prior to fund distribution date requested. The Scholarship Committee is appointed by the Board of Directors of the ZBBK and will consist of no less then three and no more then seven adults of 18 years or older.. Any relation of a standing committee member or Board of Director or Officer of the ZBBK is not eligible for any scholarship funds.

All requests for scholarship funds must include the following records:

Name and address of applicant
Purpose of funds

Amount of funds requested per year.

A negative declaration of any relationship with any committee member or ZBBK Board member or officer of the ZBBK.

2a) ZBBK Scholarship funds would be available for any student of the martial arts who has studied a martial art for over two years and is currently practicing a martial art.
